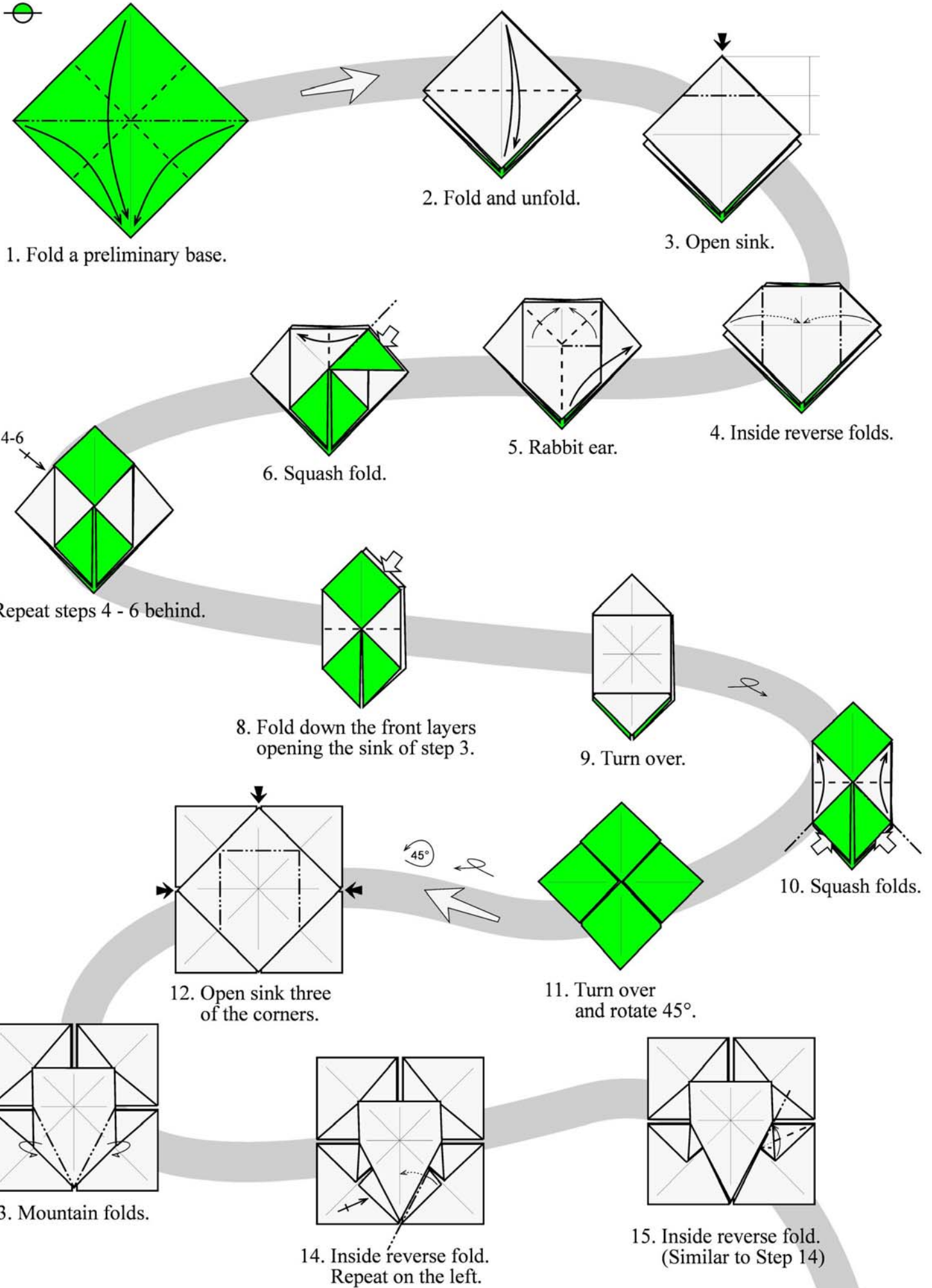
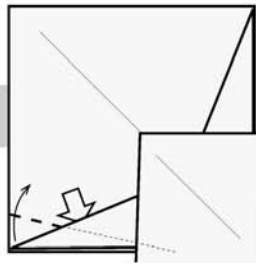


Four-Leaf Clover

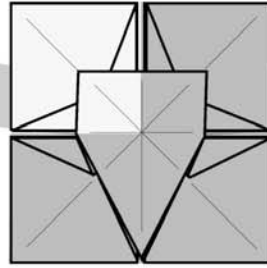

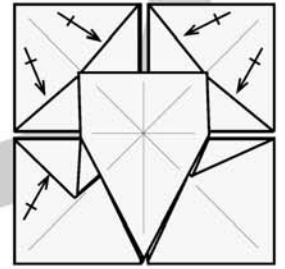




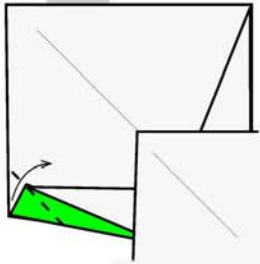
18. Swivel fold the edge. This will cause the leaf to curl away from the base slightly. Model will not lie flat.



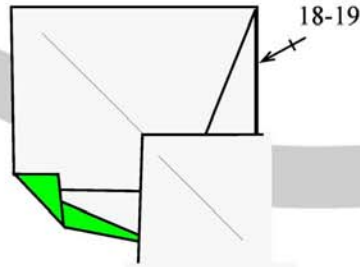
17. The next steps will focus on one leaf.



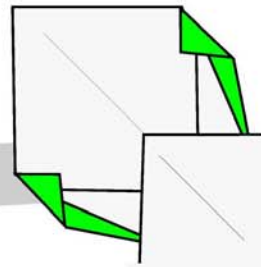
16. Repeat step 15 five more times.



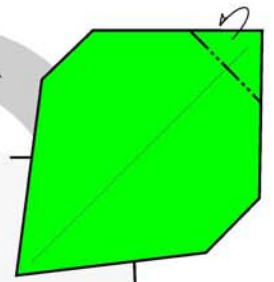
19. Lock the swivel fold with a valley fold. This also contributes to the shaping of the leaf.



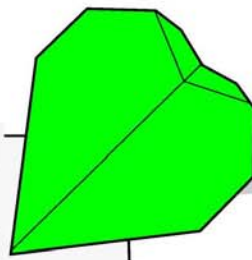
20. Repeat steps 18 - 19 on the other side.



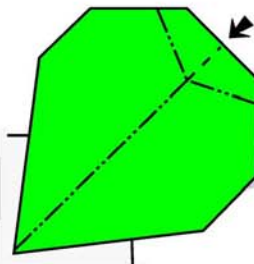
21. Turn over.



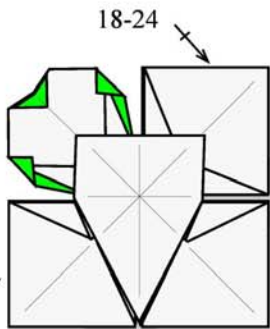
22. Mountain fold the tip of the leaf.



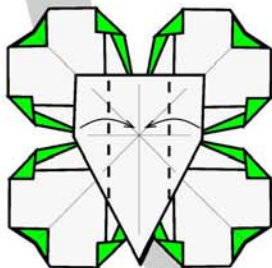
24. One leaf is finished. Turn over.



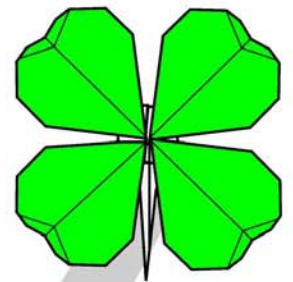
23. Shape the leaf.



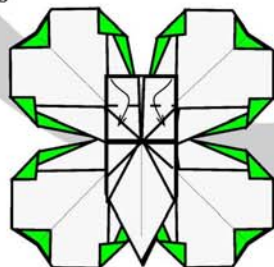
25. Repeat steps 18 - 24 on the other three leaves.



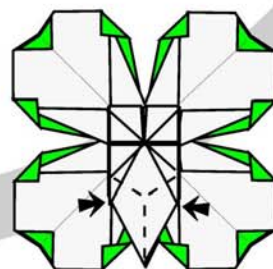
26. Valley fold the sides to the middle.
