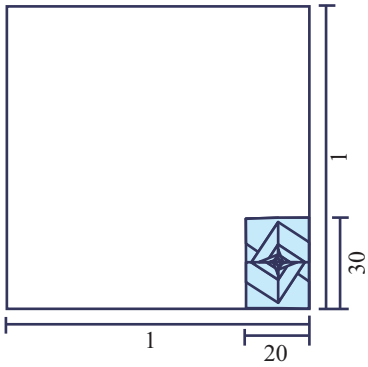


# Spiral Box

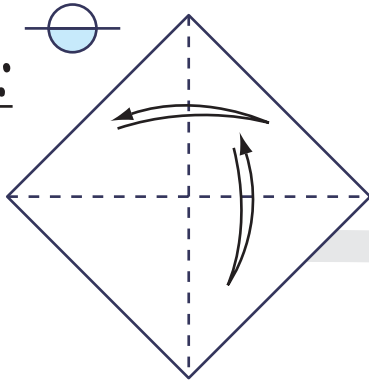


Like many of my creations this model was created when playing around with a piece of paper without any clear target. It works with nearly all kinds of paper. I especially like the locking mechanism of the lid, that gives the model a nice clean look also from the inside.

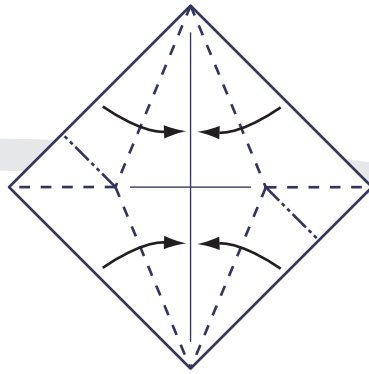
Box and Lid are made from the same paper size.

Update February 2014: I've designed a second Box to go along with my Lid.

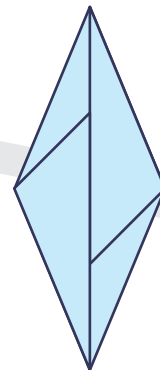

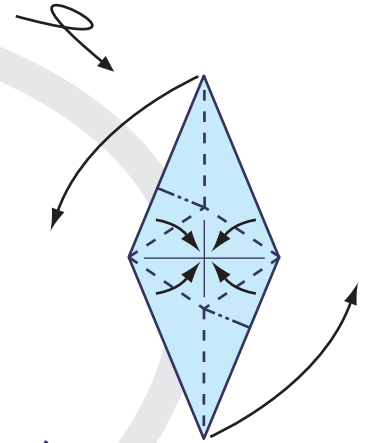
1. Fold and unfold



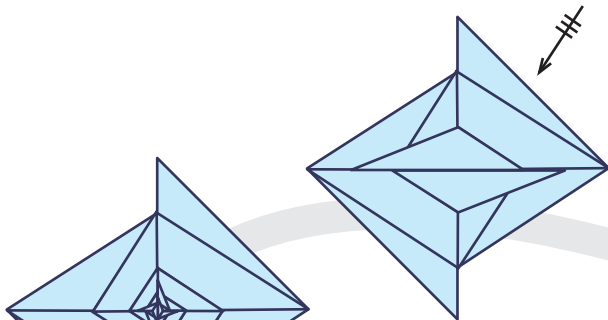
2. Rabbit Ear



3. Turn over

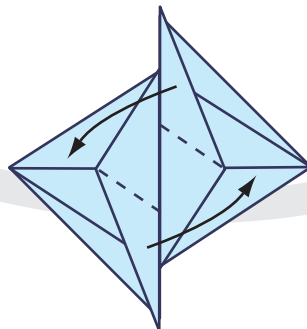

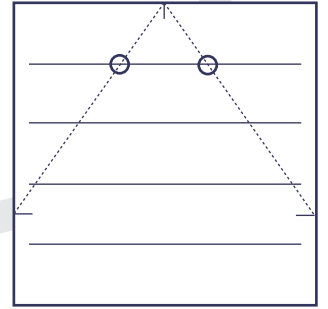
1. Divide into 5th vertically



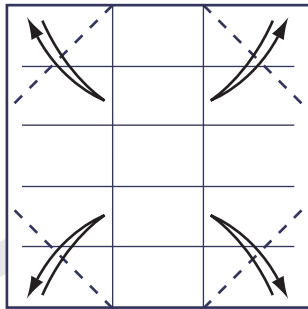
2. Pinch like shown



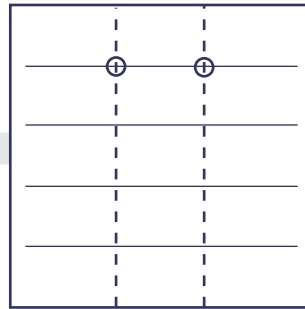
3. Pinch in half



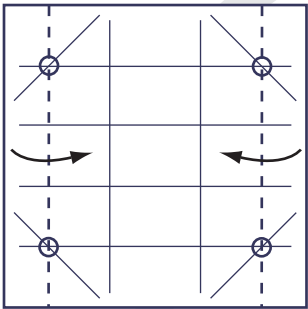
4. Pinch on the indicated points



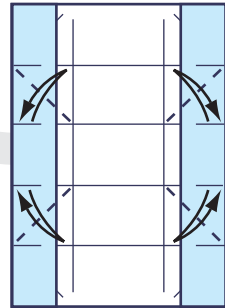
5. Valley fold and unfold through the just created points



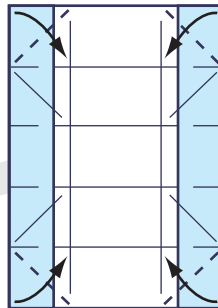

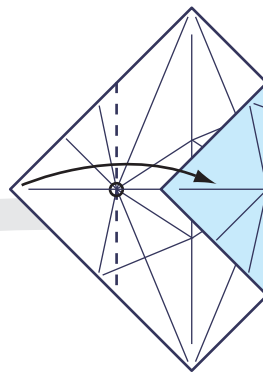
# Box 2:



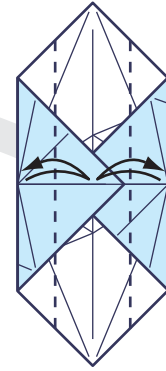
1. Begin with step 5 of the Lid. Unfold completely.



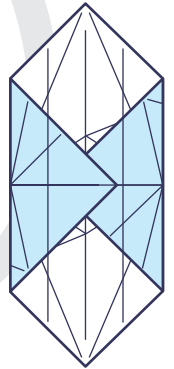
2. Fold through the point.



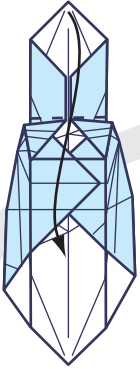
3. Repeat on the other side.



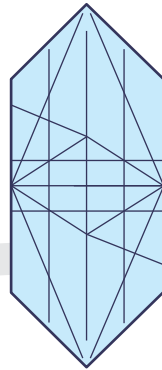
4. Fold and unfold the sides to the middle line.



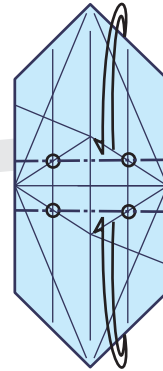
5. Turn the model over.



8. Fold three sides up at an right angle. The model becomes 3D.



7. Turn the model over.

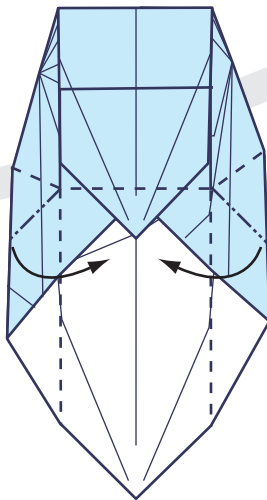


6. Mountain fold and unfold through the shown points.

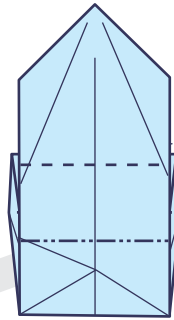
9. Valley fold along the edge.



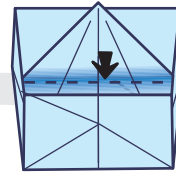
10. Press the paper into the corner and make a sharp crease.



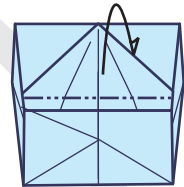
11. Repeat step 8 on the bottom of the model.



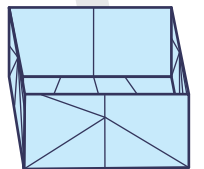
11. Repeat steps 9-10.
